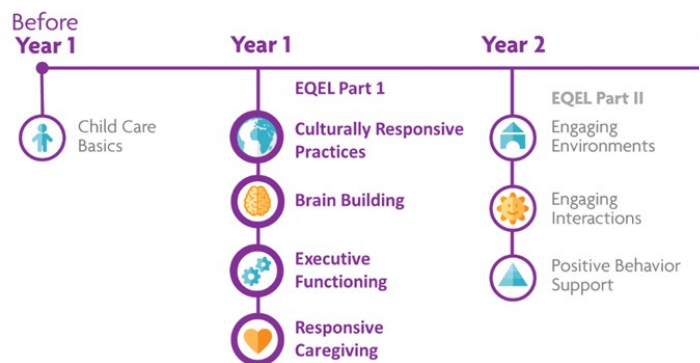
Enhancing Quality Early Learning (EQEL) Year 1 Training

Who Must Complete EQEL?

- 1) All directors and assistants, program supervisors, family home owners, lead teachers, and assistant teachers hired **on or after 8/1/19**.
- 2) Family home owners, lead teachers, and assistant teachers who are meeting the WAC education requirements through the community-based pathway option called **PACE**.

At this time, EQEL is only open to those meeting one of the above criteria.
